General Information:

The purpose of this Plantout weekend is to give volunteers from the community the opportunity to plant natives at habitat restoration sites, learn about local biodiversity projects and have an enjoyable day contributing to the greening of Canterbury.

All participants will work in groups and be directed on site. Please tell your site leader of any health issues that may be of concern. At each site a site leader will explain the process for effective planting and demonstrate the steps needed to plant in a safe manner. All equipment for planting will be provided at each site.

Day enrolment & transport:

You need to provide your own transportation to the planting site. A map is included in this kit. Please enrol on site with the TAK representative. In the case of bad weather, the event will be postponed for two weeks, listen to Newstalk ZB (1098AM, 100.1FM) for cancellation.

What we will provide:

- Morning tea & Lunch
- Tea, coffee and hot chocolate (available at each meal break)

- Shelter marquee at the meal locations
- Drinking water
- Planting equipment and gloves

What you need to bring:

- Sturdy shoes
- Hat and sunscreen
- Water bottle
- Chairs or Blanket for a picnic lunch
- A mug for hot drinks
- Wet weather gear (e.g. coat and over-pants)
- Plenty of warm clothing (the weather can quickly change and it gets cold in the afternoon)
- Children must be kept under constant supervision by their parents/carers.

Participation in the event agrees to the following conditions:

- I consent to suitably qualified and trained First Aid representatives authorising medical treatment as deemed necessary
- I understand photos may be taken and used for future promotion of the event, or that I will notify the photographer otherwise on the day
- Whilst all care is taken by the organisers, personal safety and wellbeing is an individual responsibility

5. Turn left onto **Dunsandel Rd** 5.4 km
6. Turn left onto **Mitchells Rd** 2.0 km
