Tai Tapu Bush

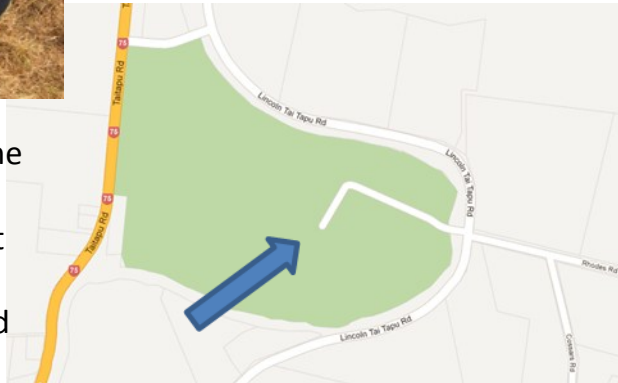
